### TOP 5 GRAFFITI VANDALISM STATISTICS



Nationally, the estimated cost of graffiti and other forms of vandalism to the Australian community is \$2.7 billion per year (Source: Australian Bureau of Statistics



In NSW alone, graffiti costs the NSW Government and property owners more than \$300 million each year



46,404 incidents of graffiti were reported to NSW Police in the five-year period from 2009 to 2014



In 2016, 20,980 square metres of graffiti was removed from sites around NSW, an area roughly twice the size of Sydney Football Stadium



In 2017, Graffiti Removal Day will be held on **Sunday 29 October**.

### It's time to Love Where We Live

Adults and children are being encouraged to become local heroes in the fight against graffiti by getting involved in Graffiti Removal Day on Sunday 29 October 2017.

Graffiti vandalism costs local businesses, households, NSW Government and local Councils millions of dollars every year. This is money which could be invested into roads, sporting facilities, schools and hospitals.

"Graffiti Removal Day draws attention to the fight against graffiti vandalism and encourages people to get involved in the removal and prevention of graffiti," event spokesperson Bob Aitken said.

"Graffiti Removal Day is a day where locals can come together in the fight against graffiti and make a real difference to the appearance of our community. We want people to 'love where we live'. That means actively caring for their city, their suburb and/or their street and also loving the result of Graffiti Removal Day."

Last year across NSW over 1500 volunteers removed 20,000m2 of graffiti from 460 sites.

"People who volunteer to help out on the day will be supplied with free cleaning material, paint, safety equipment and training on how to safely remove graffiti."
